Here at Abode, we have invested countless hours into sourcing the finest yarns and best quality fabrics possible. Our world class sheeting has been designed to become softer, smoother and more comfortable with each wash. The more careful that you are with your sheeting, the longer they will last.

Wash Before First Use - Some of the fabrics we source have shrinkage of up to 12%, so it is important to wash before first use so your products fit correctly.

Wash Often - Wash your sheeting weekly to avoid a build up of body oils. Washing less frequently will result in natural fibres like cotton and linen breaking down.



Machine Wash - Wash with care.

Front Loader: set machine to cotton cycle (1-2 hour), adjust temperature to 30 or 40 degrees, and ensure spin speed is reduced to 800rpm (express washes won't clean thoroughly, water cooler than 20 degrees won't shift body oils, and water over 40 degrees will cause fibres to become brittle and break). Don't overfill machine. Top Loader: set machine to gentle cycle with temperature at 30 or 40 degrees. A gentle spin avoids sheering out fabric and ensures maximum longevity of your bedding.



Detergents - Use a natural or neutral detergent such as a Eucalyptus based wash or a Wool wash product. Make sure the brand you're using does not contain OBA's (Optical Brightening Agents). This will cause your colours to fade. Do not use bleach. Do not use fabric softener. Whites only: To maintain white items, periodically soak in a solution of warm water and an eco-friendly brightening agent such as Ecostore Laundry soaker before washing as usual.



Drying - At Abode, all of our sheeting can be line dried and tumble dried. However, line drying will make your sheeting products last longer. If you prefer the feeling of tumble dried sheeting - try line drying until 90% dry, then finish in dryer on a warm, delicate setting, never on standard or extra-dry. Don't overfill machine. Avoid over-drying until crisp.



Ironing - If you're so inclined, it is safe to iron your Abode sheeting. Avoid using high temperatures, although steam can be set to high. You will have better results if ironing while fabric is still slightly hydrated, not 100% dry.
