Here at Abode, we have invested countless hours into sourcing the finest yarns and best quality fabrics possible. Our world class sheeting and quilt covers have been designed to become softer, smoother and more comfortable with each and every wash. The more careful you are laundering your products, the longer they will last.

Wash Before First Use - Some of the fabrics we source have shrinkage of up to 12%, so it is important to wash before first use so your products fit correctly. Washing before first use will also help eliminate excess fibres caused by the brushing process.

Wash Often - Wash your sheeting weekly to avoid a build up of body oils. Washing less frequently will cause natural fibres like cotton to rot and eventually break.

Wash Gently - Set your machine to a DELICATE or WOOLLENS setting and ensure the temperature is between 20 and 40 degrees celsius. Water cooler than 20 degrees won't shift body oils, while water hotter than 40 degrees will cause fibres to go brittle and break. Be sure to use 1-2 hour cycle, as express washes aren't long enough to clean thoroughly. Don't overfill machine. If possible reduce spin to 600 - 800 rpm to avoid sheering out fabric.

- Detergents Use a natural or neutral detergent such as a EUCALYPTUS based wash, or a wool wash product. Be sure your detergent does not contain OBA's (Optical Brightening Agents). This will cause your colours to fade. Do not use bleach. Do not use fabric softener.
- Drying At Abode, all of our sheets and quilt covers can be line dry and tumble dry, however line-drying will prolong the life of your products. If you prefer the feeling of tumble dried sheeting try line drying until 90% dry, then finish in dryer on a warm, delicate setting. Never dry sheeting on 'standard' or 'extra-dry'. Over-drying will cause sheets to go brittle. Don't overfill machine.
- Ironing Flannelette and jersey require little or no ironing however, avoid a hot iron if you prefer ironing.
