ALWAYS read care label to determine if a professional dry cleaner is required. Woollen products can be delicate and incorrect laundering will result in shrinkage, matting and/or felting.

○ **Dry Clean** - Research your local dry cleaners to determine who is capable of cleaning woollen products.

 **Hand Wash** - Some wool products require a little extra care. Hand-washing is a great way to prolong the life of your woollens, but requires some work. Fill a large bucket (or a bathtub for large blankets) with COLD water, and mix in a small amount detergent. Your woollens should have enough room to move freely. Allow woollens to soak for a few minutes in the solution before gently agitating by hand. Drain water and roll gently to remove excess water. 'HAND WASH' settings on washing machines are still technically a machine wash and potentially too vigorous.

 **Machine Wash** - Should your care label deem machine washing suitable, only use the most delicate setting.  Set machine to 'Wool' or 'Hand' wash setting. Be sure water is COLD, and cycle is set to the lowest spin.

 **Detergents** - Use a natural or neutral detergent such as a EUCALYPTUS based wash or a wool/silk wash product. Do not use bleach. Do not use fabric softener.

Drying - Dry mostly flat. Never machine dry.

Balling - Balling is normal for some wool products. Periodically remove with fabric shaver or lint remover.
